A conductor's full score is a chart, a graph which indicates frequencies, intensities, volume changes, melody, and harmony all at once and with the most exact control of time.</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Music is PHYSICAL EDUCATION</p> <p>It requires fantastic coordination of fingers, hands, arms, lip, cheek, and facial muscles, in addition to extraordinary control of the diaphragmatic, back, stomach, and chest muscles, which respond instantly to the sound the ear hears and the mind interprets.</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Music is a FOREIGN LANGUAGE</p> <p>Most of the terms are in Italian, German, or French; and the notation is certainly not English—but a highly developed kind of shorthand that uses symbols to represent ideas. The semantics of music is the most complete and universal language.</p> |
| <p style="text-align: center;">Music is HISTORY</p> <p>Music reflects the environment and times of its creation and origin of its country and or culture.</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Music is all of these things but most of all...</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Music is MATHEMATICAL</p> <p>It is rhythmically based on the subdivisions of time into fractions which must be performed, not worked out on paper.</p> |
