Carnegie Anthem (2012) - William Owens

Carnegie Anthem pays brilliant musical tribute to the venerable institution and the vibrant city it calls home. The opening statement is a bold and brilliant fanfare characterizing the splendor of the great hall itself. The subsequent middle section is a “driving calm” with engaging melodies and a rhythmic thrust symbolizing the non-stop activity of bustling NYC on any given day. -William Owens

Music From Jurassic Park (1993) - John Williams, Arr. Jay Bocook

This medley captures the richness and fullness of the two main themes from the film score. The first theme’s style is marked “gently with reverence”. Williams declares this theme as trying "to capture the awesome beauty and sublimity of the dinosaurs in nature." The “Journey to the Island” theme is an "adventure theme, high-spirited and brassy, thrilling and upbeat musically.”

O Mio Babbino Caro (2000) - Giacomo Puccini, Arr. Brian Balmages

The lyric lines of the famous aria weave a graceful tonal showcase through the full range of the solo. Taken from Puccini’s opera, *Gianni Schicchi*, written for solo Tuba or Euphonium and Band. - Brian Balmages

Morning Song (2000) - Travis Cross

Cross is a local composer and Graduate of St.Olaf who resides in Burnsville, MN. The first sketches for “Morning Song” were composed as a setting of the short poem “Nothing Gold Can Stay.” The brilliant text by Robert Frost deals with the beauty and innocence of youth as described metaphorically in the golden colors of the early morning. - Travis Cross

Quad City Stomp (2008) - Michael Sweeney

An exciting contemporary band work incorporating non-standard instruments and sound making devices. Sweeney states, “The composition is meant to be a celebration - of music, of dance, of rhythm, of love - of life.”
