### **Groove Music (2013) - Brian Balmages**

As its title suggests, *Groove Music* is a work that focuses on combinations of rhythms. The piece is composed of three sections along with a coda. Each section introduces new rhythmic elements and superimposes them to create a polyrhythmic “Groove”. The work builds dramatically and culminates in a wall of color.

### **Concerto in Eb for Trumpet (1796) - F.J. Haydn, Arr. W.J. Dutoit**

One of the staple works in the trumpet repertoire and perhaps one of the most well known concertos (at least by ear) to the general public. It was one of the first works originally written for a keyed trumpet, the precursor to today’s modern valved trumpet. Tonight’s performance features one of the band’s senior trumpet players.

### **Sheltering Sky (2012) - John Mackey**

The piece unfolds in a sweeping arch structure, with cascading phrases that elide effortlessly. The introduction presents softly articulated harmonies stacking through a surrounding placidity. From there emerge statements of each of the two folksong-like melodies—the call as a sighing descent in solo soprano saxophone, and its answer as a hopeful rising trumpet line. The melodies have a recognizable quality (hints of the contours and colors of *Danny Boy* and *Shenandoah*), however both are original to the work, imparting a sense of hazy distance as though they were from a half-remembered dream.—Jake Wallace

### **Paper Cut (2010) - Alex Shapiro**

Music isn’t just melody; its rhythm and texture as well. The unusual element of paper and the myriad sounds that can emerge from something so simple offer a fresh view of what music-making can be and opens everyone’s ears to the sonic possibilities found among every day objects.—Alex Shapiro

### **Second Suite in F for Military Band (1922) - Gustav Holst**

Holst is perhaps most famous for his suite of pieces entitled “The Planets” and his two suites for military band in F and Eb. The military band suites were some of the first pieces to show the world that bands were capable of “serious music” beyond marches, polkas, and dance tunes. This suite is based upon several folk song melodies organized into four characterful movements.
