Celtic Carol (2002), Arr. Robert W. Smith

This is a setting of the traditional melody known during the holiday season as, "What Child Is This?" Featuring the percussion section throughout, this particular setting draws the listener into a traditional Irish Celebration. The Celebration begins with a mysterious solo statement based on the first lines of the carol and ends with a very exciting conclusion. - Robert W. Smith

On A Hymnsong of Philip Bliss (1989), by David R. Holsinger

Holsinger based this work upon the Horatio Spafford hymn, "It is Well with my Soul", which the hymn-writer wrote in response to the tragic loss of his four daughters in a shipwreck in 1873. This restful, gentle, and reflective composition is the composer's largest selling work and has been used in several televised memorial services including commemorative services for the Challenger Astronauts, Ronald Reagan, and the fallen heroes of the American Armed Forces.

Sleigh Ride (1948), Leroy Anderson

The composer had the original idea for this piece during a heat wave in July 1946 but did not complete the work until February 1948. It was originally an instrumental piece and it was not until 1950 when lyrics were written by Mitchell Parish. The orchestral version was first recorded in 1949 by Arthur Fiedler and the Boston Pops Orchestra.

Patapan (2001), Arr. Tom Wallace

The onomatopoeic sound of which gives this traditional french carol its name; "patapan" is meant to mimic the sound of the drum, and an accompanying lyric, "tu-re-lu-re-lu," the flute. This clever arrangement begins and ends with these instruments and includes medieval harmonies, utilizing many perfect intervals (4ths, 5ths and 8ves).

Firebird Suite: Berceuse and Finale (1910), Igor Stravinsky Arr. Robert Longfield

The Firebird was the first of three ballets written by Igor Stravinsky during the early years of the twentieth century. The ballet is based upon several Russian fairy tales and tells the story of Prince Ivan, who rescues the princess he loves from the evil enchanter Kastchei with the aid of the Firebird: a creature half-bird, half woman, with magical powers. This piece culminates in a dazzling, majestic wall of color.
