Kinetic Dances (2015) - Randall Standridge

Kinetic Dances is a dance for symphonic band in mixed meter. The rhythmic interchange between 7/8 and 4/4 time are utilized to create a unique rhythmic flow for the work. The challenge when writing this was to make the meter feel as natural as possible. The piece is in a slightly modified Rondo form, with the main theme alternating with contrasting sections. —R.S.

Prelude and Fugue in Bb Major (1722) - J.S. Bach

Bach wrote just over 1,200 compositions during his life and became foundational in guiding the development of the western music tradition. This is one of the nearly 200 preludes and fugues, originally written for pipe organ, that has been arranged for band.

Fantasy on “Yankee Doodle”(1995) - Mark Williams

The work begins with a vigorous fanfare leading into a humorous statement of the theme by solo tuba. This light, quirky treatment of the theme is followed by a dark, moody variant. A spirited Allegro transforms the mood to one of joyous expectation. After a lyric episode, a Latin percussion vamp eventually leads to a full statement of the theme in half notes. The final Maestoso fanfare leads the work to a satisfying and exciting close. —M.W.

Dragonheart (1995) - Randy Edelman, Arr. Frank Bernaerts

Centered Main heroic theme taken from the title of the movie namesake. *Dragonheart* follows the fictional story of a sole remaining dragon and a disillusioned dragonslaying knight who must cooperate to stop an evil king who was given partial immortality.

Tocatta for Band (1957) - Frank Erickson

A staple in the band repertoire, the piece opens with an energetic woodwind flourish before breaking off into a clarinet chorale. The piece quickly transitions into a comfortable lyrical section features a heartfelt melody and lush harmonies before returning to the opening material.

The Crosley March (1928) - Henry Fillmore

Henry Fillmore was a successful and popular band leader with the Syrian Temple Shrine Band in Cincinnati in the early 1900's. The Fillmore band performed a regular series of broadcasts over the radio station WLW in Cincinnati. The owner of the radio station was a business man and personal friend of Fillmore named Powell Crosley and it is for him that this march is named. —Program Notes
